Youth Intensive Outpatient Program

The Youth Intensive Outpatient Program (YIOP) offers comprehensive services with a focus on skill building, symptom reduction, family engagement, and parent coaching. This intensive treatment option focuses on addressing maladaptive forms of coping through developing emotional awareness and increasing positive behaviors.

YIOP is a level of care for adolescents 12–18 who are struggling with symptoms of mental illness that interfere with their ability to function at home, at school, and in the community.
